At the Town Hall of Lugano, on April 21st, Anna Bacchia has presented the cultural programs developed by her Project ININ One Earth Choir towards 55 Nations worldwide. Ervin Lazlo has founded the Club of Budapest Switzerland.

On the theme 'many native languages, one only *human language*' the *intercultural Project ININ One Earth Choir*, connects Lugano with 55 Nations. On April 21st, at the Town Hall of Lugano, Switzerland, the Author of the Project Anna Bacchia, with the co-producer Roman Calzaferri and with the Project's Team, have presented to the Honorable Mayor Marco Borradori and to the Head of the Cultural Department, Giovanna Masoni Brenni, the three most relevant cultural developments of One Earth Choir: the Foundation of the Club of Budapest Switzerland, among Science Art and Culture, the cooperation with the worldwide project for Peace created by the Goi Peace Foundation of Tokyo, and the launch of the ININ Educational Program in the world: 'Voice and Intuitive Intelligence'.

In such context the Mayor Marco Borradori and the Head of the Cultural Department, Giovanna Masoni Brenni, have met the Scientist, founder of the Club of Budapest and Nobel Peace candidate Ervin Laszlo, together with Maria Sagi of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences and Science Director of the Club of Budapest, and Dana Amma Day, President of the Club of Budapest UK and founder of the English television 'Positive TV'.

Foundation of the Club of Budapest Switzerland

Since the 1990's, one of the most prestigious International Foundation for culture science and art, the Club of Budapest (CoB), proposes the most advanced scientific and cultural paradigms in order to co-create and develop innovative,

efficient and sustainable strategies and programs with a global approach. On such basis, its Founder, the scientist Ervin Laszlo, is individuating the most relevant intercultural projects and connecting them in an international network. In such context, for the Project ÌNIN One Earth Choir and for the ÌNIN Educational Programs, on the 21st of April, Laszlo officially has founded in Lugano the Club of Budapest Switzerland, and has nominated as its director Anna Bacchia, author of the ÌNIN Projects.

ÌNIN, an international educational Project on the theme of INTUITION

For the Foundation of the CoB Switzerland and its International programs, Anna Bacchia has presented the intercultural Educational Projects ÌNIN on the theme of Intuitive Intelligence. She has focused on the innovative aspects of such projects, with the sentence of Albert Einstein:

"The intuitive mind is a sacred gift, and the rational mind is a faithful servant. We have created a society that honors the servant and has forgotten the gift".

The ÌNIN Projects on 'Voice and Intuitive Mind' are already active in Lugano at the School for Contemporary Music SMUM, and are proposed through the networks of ÌNIN One Earth Choir and of the CoB.

On May 16th, a worldwide Project for Peace will connect Lugano with Tokyo

In the context of the partnership among One Earth Choir, the CoB and one of the grandest worldwide Foundations for Peace, the Goi Peace Foundation of Tokyo, a direct streaming connection between Lugano and Japan will be created on May 16th, in order to share the worldwide Project of Peace launched from Tokyo. The ceremony for Peace will be opened at the foot of Mount Fuji, and contemporarily at the foot of the Mountain Bré in Lugano, with the performance of the musical theme ÌNIN of One Earth Choir: a Music which represents 'many native languages, one only *human* language' and 'unity within diversity'.

At the LAC: the new Cultural Center, the City of Lugano donates a tree to One Earth Choir.

The foundation and the launch (in 2012) of One Earth Choir from Lugano will be marked in Lugano by a tree, which will be planted in the park of the new cultural center LAC. The City of Lugano has donated a plant to the One Earth Choir Project and to the children of the schools of the city, which have dedicated their drawings to One Earth Choir and invited children from all over the world to join the grandest Choir on Earth, which in 2015 has involved more than 3.5 million people.

On April 21st, in the Council Chamber of the Town Hall, the youngest participants to this initiative, the second grade of Lambertenghi Elementary School taught by Florinda Montalbano Baldo, presented their drawings to the Mayor Borradori, to Ervin Laszlo and to Giovanna Masoni Brenni.

In such context, the scientist Ervin Laszlo, symbolic conductor of One Earth Choir, has given a baton of conduction to a child from Lugano, as symbolic dedication of the cultural Projects to the future generations.

The Mayor Marco Borradori and the municipal councilor Giovanna Masoni Brenni have underlined the social and innovative values of the One Earth Choir and of the intercultural Projects launched from the City of Lugano by Anna Bacchia with Ervin Laszlo of the Club of Budapest and with Hiroo and Masami Saionji of the Goi Peace Foundation of Tokyo.
